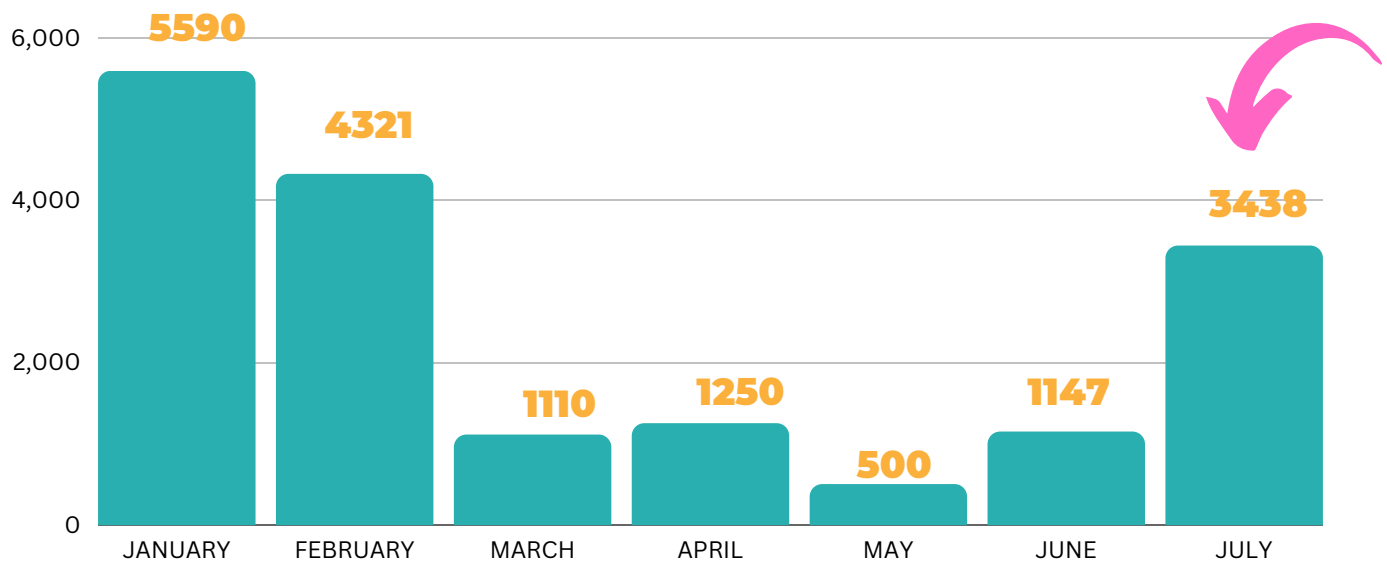
JULY RECAP



In the month of July, we expanded our outreach in Guanta, Anzoategui, and provided meals to **over 3,400 people**, including both children and vulnerable adults. Kids Day was a significant highlight during which we organized events nationwide, benefiting more than **1,600 children and adults in need**. While we acknowledge that we are still short of our ambitious goal of 100,000 meals for the year, we remain unwavering in our commitment. We will continue working tirelessly to ensure that every vulnerable person, regardless of age, receives the nutrition they require to break free from the cycle of poverty. Together, we can make a meaningful difference in the lives of those who need it the most.

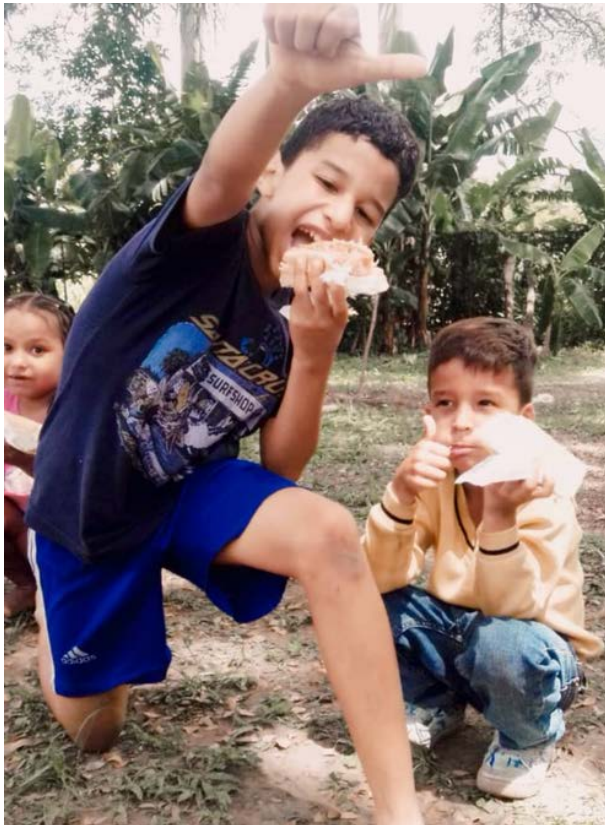

Our team will select a different community each day, and host them with a meal, activity, and community. We will be highlighting this program on our Instagram, so be sure to follow along for the adventure! With this month-long activity, we will feed 3,000 people in Guanta alone!
