We are also pleased to share the amazing work that we have been doing in Trujillo, Venezuela, with the help of our partners, Fundacion Dibujando Sonrisas.


This month, we were able to sponsor several community activities that brought joy and hope to the most vulnerable communities, promoting values of solidarity and respect for the youngest members of our society.
