
JUNE RECAP



June was filled with several events all around Venezuela, including 10 meal activities in 4 different states. We formed a new partnership with a foundation in Maracaibo, Venezuela, allowing us to serve children in many vulnerable neighborhoods there who need a helping hand. In total we served 1,147 meals, getting us closer to our goal of 100,000 for the year. Though a long ways to go, we have big things planned for the second half of the year, and continue to be amazed at the support of our community in helping us generate real change in vulnerable communities all across Venezuela.

Our partners, Foundation Drawing Smiles, distributed 200 trays of food for us to people who were waiting for their hospitalized relatives, medical staff and care center worker in the emergency area. We received a very strong response from many people, grateful for a hot plate of food during a difficult time. Many had traveled from very far and couldn't otherwise afford to eat.



Community Cinema Nights

Two nights in June, our team hosted a Community Cinema Night, where they provided a free movie, sandwiches, and juice, for the community. Two nights of 150 kids were hosted, and fun and a true sense of community was enjoyed by all. These communities are very vulnerable, so providing a safe and positive environment, as well as a plate of food, is very important for the kids.

New Partnership Highlight

June began the beginning of a new partnership for us with a foundation that hosts their own diners across extremely depressed communities in Maracaibo. They currently operate 3 daily diners, but a lot of days cannot afford to open due to lack of donations. We sponsored 3 days of lunches and plan on doing many more. They utilize a nutritionist to ensure these children are receiving the protein and nutrients they need to grow. The days the diners are unable to open, the kids unfortunately still line up hoping for food we are told. We cannot stop our mission until these kids have daily nutritious lunches. We have the blessings and affordability to help!

The Menu

We often get asked about the meals that we provide, and how we keep costs so low. We pride ourselves on meals that are nutirious, and cost around \$0.56/plate, so we can maximize every dollar and feed as many people as possible. Many of the people we serve wouldn't otherwise have a hot meal, so it's important to reach as many people as we can, with our limited funds and budget.

Example 1



Menu: Rice with chicken, salad, bread and iuice

Rice = \$12.61 Chickens = \$15 Sausage = \$10 Bread = \$12 Juice = \$15

Seasonings = \$15 Salad = \$20 Mayonnaise = \$8.01

Total Cost: **\$107.62**Cost per Meal: **\$0.54**Total People Served: **200 People**

Example 2



Menu: Pasta with ground meat, salad, bread and juice

Pasta = \$52.57 Meat = \$20.80 Dressings & vegetables = \$15 200 bread = \$12 Natural juice = \$15 Salad = \$20 Mayonnaise = \$8.01

Total Cost: **\$143.38**Cost per Meal: **\$0.71**
