JANUARY NEW PARTNERSHIP

January brought a very wonderful, new partnership for the My Angel Foundation, Fundacion Dibujando Sonrisas. This group is based in Trujillo, a very economically depressed area in Venezuela, where poverty is the norm, and food is very scarce. We have partnered with this group to bring over 1,000 meals to their community, with the gracious help of their volunteers who prepare all the meals. They travel the streets with prepared foods and hand it out to those in need of a healthy meal. We believe this partnership will help us expand our outreach to even more desolate and depressed communities in Venezuela, where there is not a lot of service or outreach. Through this partnership, we were able to feed a school of 200 students pasta and meat, many of whom had never had meat before due to the cost.

The Sermadiesal Soccer team is a neighborhood group of kids, living in extreme poverty, who have one thing in common, a love for soccer. Soccer not only is their passion, but it keeps them out of trouble, focused on a common goal, and practicing key life skills such as being a good teammate, athleticism, and community. Most of these kids come to their soccer games without shoes and without having had a proper meal that day. We have committed to feeding them at least once weekly, provided them with proper shoes, and donated uniforms to them. One teammmate was so excited for the uniforms because, as he said, "now we won't be made fun of anymore for not having matching shirts".

There are 40 kids, aging from 5-13 in this group, all of whom are grateful for the opportunity to be on a soccer team together.
